# INTRODUCTION

**Doukhobor Ship Passenger Lists** provides both the historian and the genealogist with an indispensable guide of Doukhobor passengers who came to Canada from Russia in 1898 to 1928. This book is compiled from the original ship passenger lists held at the National Archives of Canada. The lists were completed on board by the ship's purser and filed with customs and immigration authorities upon arrival at Canadian ports.

Such lists constitute the official record of Doukhobor immigration to Canada, and include essential information on the name, family group, age, sex, occupation and intended destination of each Doukhobor passenger. The lists indicate the name, line and captain of the ship, dates of departure and arrival, and ports of departure and arrival. The lists also indicate births and deaths at sea, hospitalization and quarantine.

This book contains over 5,200 passenger names taken from over 30 lists. It does not purport to be all-inclusive, however, as the lists for over 3,200 Doukhobor passengers are either lost or incomplete. Moreover, new lists are constantly being discovered and brought to the attention of the authors, so that the total number of possible listings grows daily.

**Doukhobor Ship Passenger List** is divided into four parts corresponding to the four major waves of Doukhobor immigration to Canada in 1898 to 1899, 1902 to 1906, 1910 to 1912 and 1925 to 1928.

Part One contains passenger lists for the period 1898 to 1899. During this time, over 7,500 Doukhobors sailed from the Black Sea port of Batum to the Canadian ports of Halifax and Quebec. These transatlantic voyages were co-funded by Russian novelist Count Leo Tolstoy and by the Society of Friends (Quakers) in England and America. It was the largest mass immigration in Canadian history.

Part Two contains passenger lists for the period 1902 to 1906. During this time, over 200 Doukhobors took coastal ships from Russia to the ports of Liverpool and Bremen, where they boarded transatlantic ships bound for Canada. These were Doukhobors detained in Russia until their terms of exile or military service had expired. Their voyages were funded by the Doukhobor community in Canada.

Part Three contains passenger lists for the period 1910 to 1912. During this time, over 670 Doukhobors took coastal ships from Russia to the ports of Liverpool, Southampton, Bristol, Glasgow, Antwerp and Hamburg, where they boarded transatlantic ships bound for Canada. This wave of "late arrivals" may have been prompted by fears of conscription in the impending war between Germany and Russia.

Doukhobor immigration to Canada was halted on June 9, 1919 when the Parliament of Canada passed Order-in-Council P.C. 1204 prohibiting the landing in Canada of any

Doukhobor, Hutterite or Mennonite because of their "peculiar habits, modes of life and methods of holding property". By the time the Order was repealed on March 1, 1925, the Soviet regime had placed rigid restrictions on emigration outside the U.S.S.R. Part Four of this book contains passenger lists for the period that followed from 1925 to 1928.

All passenger name spellings have been standardized according to the *Library of Congress System*.

The following terms are used throughout this book:

- *Purser*. Ship's officer in charge of provisions, dispatches, accounts and compiling passenger lists. The purser compiled the passenger list during the voyage. Passengers were listed alphabetically, by ticket number, or in the order in which they boarded.
- *Quarantine*. Term during which a ship arriving in port and suspected of carrying contagious disease is held in isolation from the shore. The quarantine might last from several days to several weeks, depending on the disease. Following a general medical examination, ship, passenger and cargo were fumigated and disinfected. Passengers were also vaccinated. Hundreds of Doukhobor immigrants were detained at the Quarantine Stations on Grosse Isle, Quebec and Lawlor's Island, Nova Scotia in order to isolate and prevent the spread of small pox, measles and diphtheria.
- *Steerage*. With few exceptions, the Doukhobors sailed to Canada in steerage class. The term steerage was synonymous with the hardships of transatlantic voyages as passengers were packed into dangerous quarters and each was allotted a small berth that served as bed and storage place. It was the only class most Doukhobors could afford and was literally next to the ship's steering equipment, below the water line.
- *SS*. Abbreviation for Steam Ship.

## S.S. VANCOUVER [1898]

### S.S. VANCOUVER <sup>1</sup>

---

This Dominion line steamship departed September 1, 1898, under Captain P.O. Jones, from the port of Liverpool, England. It carried 357 passengers, including 9 Doukhobors from the Caucasus, the first to set foot on Canadian soil. These were the families of Ivan Ivín and Peter Makhortov, Doukhobor delegates chosen to select suitable lands for settlement. Also accompanied by immigration organizers Aylmer Maude and Prince Dmitry Khilkov. After 10 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of Quebec on September 10, 1898. The intended destination of all Doukhobor passengers is listed as Winnipeg, Manitoba.

## S.S. LAKE HURON [1899]

### S.S. LAKE HURON <sup>2</sup>

---

This Beaver line steamship departed December 23, 1898, under Captain G.C. Evans, from the Black Sea port of Batum. It carried 2,140 Doukhobors from Tiflis province, ten of whom died en route and one was born. Also accompanied by voyage organizer Leopold Sulerzhitsky, ship doctor Mercer, Dr. Alexei Bakunin and doctor's assistant Maria Satz. Due to fierce storms en route, the voyage lasted 32 days. On January 20, 1899, the vessel arrived at the port of Halifax, Nova Scotia and underwent quarantine examination at Lawlor's Island on January 21. On January 23, 1899, the passengers disembarked at St. John, New Brunswick. Note that this ship passenger list is incomplete; the original copy was lost in Winnipeg, Manitoba by Immigration Branch officials and is presumed destroyed.

## S.S. LAKE SUPERIOR <sup>3</sup>

---

This Beaver line steamship departed January 4, 1899, under Captain W.H. Taylor, from the Black Sea port of Batum. It carried 1,342 Doukhobors from Elizavetpol province, 647 Doukhobors from Kars province and 8 Doukhobors from Tiflis province. 3 Doukhobors died en route and one was born. Also accompanied by voyage organizer Count Sergei Tolstoy, medical attendant Efrosina Khiryakova and midwife Maria Chekhovich. After 24 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of Halifax, Nova Scotia on January 27, 1899. Due to one case of small pox, the ship passengers underwent quarantine at Lawlor's Island for 27 days. On February 18, 1899, the passengers disembarked at St. John, New Brunswick. Note that this ship passenger list is incomplete as the ship's purser recorded only 899 of the 1,997 Doukhobor passengers on board.

## S.S. LAKE SUPERIOR <sup>4</sup>

---

This Beaver line steamship departed April 18, 1899, under Captain W.H. Taylor, from the port of Larnaca, Cyprus. It carried 1,036 Doukhobors, formerly of Tiflis province, who resettled in Cyprus in 1898. One died en route and one was born. Also accompanied by voyage organizer Leopold Sulerzhitsky, doctor Mercer, nurses Anna Rabets and Alexandra Satz, and Doukhobor sympathizers Arthur St. John, William Bellows, Elizaveta Markova, Anna de Caroussa and Haratailo Andronew. After 26 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of Quebec on May 9, 1899. Following a brief quarantine examination at Grosse Isle, the passengers disembarked that day.

## S.S. LAKE HURON<sup>5</sup>

---

This Beaver line steamship departed May 12, 1899, under Captain G.C. Evans, from the Russian port of Batum on the Black Sea. It carried 2,286 Doukhobors from Kars province. Six died en route and two were born. Accompanied by Dr. Vera Velichkina, nurse Maria Rabets, medical attendant Efrosina Khiriakova. Also accompanied by Doukhobor sympathizers Alexander N. Konshin and Vladimir Olkhovsky (aka Vladimir Bonch-Bruevich, Doukhobor ethnographer) and 6 non-Doukhobor Russian pacifists. After 25 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of Quebec on June 6, 1899. Due to smallpox, the ship and passengers underwent quarantine at Gross Isle for 27 days. On July 3 and 4, 1899, the passengers disembarked at Quebec.

It carried 670 passengers, including 56 Doukhobors from Elizavetpol and Kars provinces. After 12 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of Quebec on July 20, 1899. Frequently overlooked by writers and historians, this "forgotten fifth ship" carried the families of Doukhobor military personnel detained in Russia until their terms of military service expired.

After 13 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of St. Johns, New Brunswick on December 15, 1902. Due to measles, the ship and passengers underwent quarantine inspection for 3 days. On December 18, 1902, the passengers disembarked at St. Johns.

It carried 649 passengers, including 182 Doukhobors exiles from Yakutsk, Siberia. Also accompanied by five non-Doukhobor Russian pacifists. After 10 days at sea, the vessel arrived at the port of Quebec on September 9, 1905. Thirty Doukhobors were detained at the Immigration Hospital in Quebec until October. Due to measles, an additional four Doukhobors were quarantined at Grosse Isle until November 17, 1905.
